General Information

The **Republic of Senegal** is a country in West Africa. Senegal is bordered by Mauritania in the north, Mali to the east, Guinea to the southeast, and Guinea-Bissau to the southwest. Senegal also borders the Gambia, a country occupying a narrow sliver of land along the banks of the Gambia River, which separates Senegal's southern region of Casamance from the rest of the country. Senegal also shares a maritime border with Cape Verde. Senegal's economic and political capital is Dakar.

Senegal covers a land area of almost 197,000 square kilometers and has an estimated population of about 15 million. The climate is typically Sahelian, though there is a rainy season. Senegal has a tropical climate with pleasant heat throughout the year with well-defined dry and humid seasons that result from northeast winter winds and southwest summer winds. The dry season (December to April) is dominated by hot, dry wind. Dakar's annual rainfall of about 600 mm (24 in) occurs between June and October when maximum temperatures average 30 °C (86.0 °F) and minimums 24.2 °C (75.6 °F); December to February maximum temperatures average 25.7 °C (78.3 °F) and minimums 18 °C (64.4 °F).

Electricity

All sockets in Senegal provide a standard **voltage** of 230V with a **frequency** of 50Hz. You can use all your equipment in Senegal if the standard **voltage** in your own country is between 220V-240V.



Official Languages

The official language of the Republic of Senegal is French though some other languages including English are used.

Money and Banking

Currency and exchange rates

The official currency of the Republic of Senegal is the CFA franc, West African CFA franc. For current exchange rates: https://www.oanda.com/currency/converter/

Foreign currency can be changed at the airport, which has 24hr service, banks and foreign currency exchange bureaus. ATM services are more widely available at designated booth locations in the various malls, selected

convenience stores at gas/petrol stations. Banks open from Monday to Friday from 08h30 to 11h00 and from 14h00 to 16h00. Shopping centers open from Monday to Saturday, from 8h00 to 12h00 and from 15h00 to 19h30. Major international cards are accepted.

Passports and Visas

Every participant is responsible for checking the visa requirements for their respective country. ECOWAS member countries, European Union, Brazil, Canada, Djibouti, Japan, India, Kenya and United States are not need visa to enter to Senegal

Participants who registered online or sent passport numbers by email by the 6th of March 2019 and require visa, will receive their visas upon arrival. The rest will have to apply for visas in their home country before departure. The visa fees for AUDA-NEPAD sponsored delegates will be reimbursed. Kindly keep the original receipt for visa fees. A yellow fever vaccination certificate is required for entry into Senegal.

Wi - Fi

Free Wi-Fi facility will be available in all meeting rooms. Details will be provided on the meeting days.
