- » A detailed appraisal of national and regional industrialisation policies and plans.
- 33 national and four regional industrialisation policies/plans in COMESA, SADC, EAC and ECOWAS (including Comoros) were appraised. The report will be launched in 2020.

Strengthening African Medical Health Regulation » Domestication of AU Model Law on Medical Products.

- 28 countries, including Comoros, are at different stages towards domesticating the AU Model Law on Medical Products. >>
- » 14 Member States are implementing the Model Law.
