Elaborating Scope and Baseline

- » A detailed appraisal of national and regional industrialisation policies and plans.
- » 33 national and four regional industrialisation policies/plans in COMESA, SADC, EAC and ECOWAS (including Eritrea) were appraised. The report will be launched in 2020.
