Job creation toolkit for infrastructure projects

The PIDA job creation toolkit was launched. The toolkit estimates, amongst others, direct, indirect and induced jobs in job years during the preparation, construction and O&M phase.

Policy and regulatory frameworks for PIDA projects

21 countries, (including Gabon) were trained on water governance and international law with regards to transboundary waters in Africa.

Food Safety and Quality Management

- » Strengthening institutional capacities for the development and implementation of effective food safety control systems.
- » To integrate nutrition and food safety in the CAADP national agriculture invest plans (NAIPs), initial technical support was provided to four countries, one of which was Gabon.
- » Guidelines for cross-border harmonisation of food safety standards and regulations were developed for Gabon.

Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM)

STEM Education was launched and needs assessments were undertaken in five countries, including Gabon.
