Multimodal transport connectivity for economic development

Within the UMA region Libya together with four other countries commenced preparations of feasibility study on the trans-Maghreb highway.

Virtual PIDA information centre

Data collection on PIDA commenced in five countries including Libya in the UMA region. Furthermore, regional and national-level strategies were defined to improve data collection processes. Support was provided in strengthening capacity of UMA to monitor infrastructure development in the region.

Elaborating Scope and Baseline

- » A detailed appraisal of national and regional industrialisation policies and plans commenced.
- » 33 national and four regional industrialisation policies/plans in COMESA, SADC, EAC and ECOWAS were appraised. The report will be launched in 2020.
