### Elaborating Scope and Baseline

- » A detailed appraisal of national and regional industrialisation policies and plans.
- » 33 national and four regional industrialisation policies/plans in COMESA, SADC, EAC and ECOWAS (including Mauritius) were appraised. The report will be launched in 2020.

### Strengthening African Medical Health Regulation

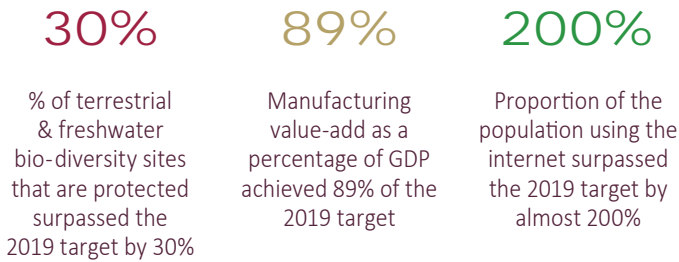
- » Domestication of AU Model Law on Medical Products.

# Southern Africa Dashboard on Implementation of Agenda 2063

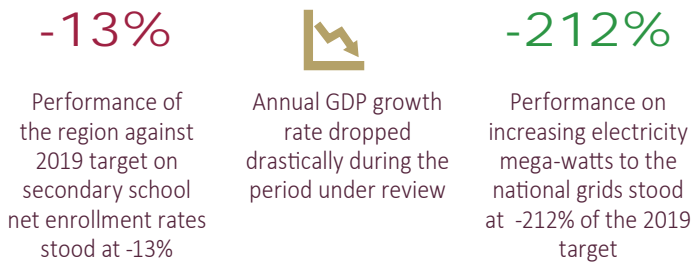
