Agenda 2063

Seychelles is among 31 African countries to have shared their first national progress report on Agenda 2063's first Ten-Year Implementation Plan. The first-ever continental report assesses progress made at the national, regional and continental levels towards achieving Africa's developmental goals. The report was launched at the 2020 January AU Summit by President of Côte d'Ivoire, Alassane Ouattara.

African Science Technology and Innovation Indicators (ASTII)

- » The lessons learnt from drafting African Innovation Outlook 3 (AIO-3) led to the modification of the national R&D and Innovation survey instruments. Seychelles is among the countries that have expressed interest to pilot the modified instruments.
- » Developed a full database on the status of innovation in Seychelles focused on product and process innovations, and with the organisational and marketing innovations partially treated.
- » Analysed the status of Research & Development (R&D) Investments as a Proportion of GDP in Seychelles, focused on Business, Government, Higher Education and Private Non-Profit sectors of the economy.

Grow Africa

- » Boosting private sector participation in Africa's agricultural transformation.
- » Support was provided towards the establishment of country agribusiness partnership frameworks (CAP-F) in 11 countries, including Seychelles.
- » Seychelles supported the establishment of an Integrated Agriculture-Aquaculture Hub. The aquaculture sector is one of the priority areas of the Seychelles NAIP.

Elaborating Scope and Baseline

- » A detailed appraisal of national and regional industrialisation policies and plans.
- » 33 national and four regional industrialisation policies /plans in COMESA, SADC, EAC and ECOWAS (including Seychelles) were appraised. The report will be launched in 2020.

Strengthening African Medical Health Regulation

- » Domestication of AU Model Law on Medical Products.
- » 28 countries, including Seychelles, are at different stages towards domesticating the AU Model Law on Medical Products.
- » The Seychelles has domesticated an adapted version of the African Union Model on Medical Products with the aim to improve access to quality and safe drugs and to fight the circulation of fake medical products in the country.

Biennial Review Report on the Status of Agriculture in Africa

According to the Comprehensive Africa Agriculture Development Programme (CAADP) Biennial Review Report, Seychelles strongly performed in the CAADP process. Seychelles scored 81% for evidencebased policies supportive institutions and corresponding human resources; 100% of men and women engaged in agriculture having access to financial services; 100% farmers having access to agriculture advisory services; 92% of rural women have access to productive assets in agriculture (empowered); and 6.3% of total agriculture research spending as a share of agriculture GDP.
