SPONSORED PARTICIPANTS

For participants sponsored by the NEPAD Agency, the cost of your travel (economy class), accommodation (bed and breakfast only) and daily subsistence allowance (DSA) will be covered only for the agreed period of the meeting. Reimbursement of visa expenses will be done upon submission of original receipts.

Upon receipt of your confirmation, air travel will be booked on your behalf on economy class based cheapest and shortest route available. E-tickets will only be issued upon your

confirmation of the itinerary. Once the e-ticket is issued, any changes will be at the traveller's expense. Should you not be able to attend the workshop after your confirmation of attendance due to unforeseen circumstances, please inform us 48 hours prior to date of travel.

Please note that you are responsible for all other costs and incidentals (mini bar, laundry, telephone, internet, dinner, sundries etc.).

3. VISAS

Participants are responsible for visa arrangements and proceedings in compliance with their country's visa requirements.

However, note that the NEPAD Agency has liaised with the Government of Cameroon in order to facilitate VISA on arrival of invited participants.

4. AIRPORT TRANSFERS AND LOCAL TRANSPORT

At the airport there will be ushers from NEPAD Agency at the arrival terminal to direct you to the shuttles.

A shuttle will be made available for participants from the Yaoundé Airport to their respective hotels. Buses will be also available from these hotels to the conference venue.

5. BADGES AND SECURITY

In order to obtain access badges to the meeting rooms, participants will need to present their passport or equivalent national identity card (with photo) at the registration desk situated at the Hilton reception area.

Registration will open at 8:00 a.m. We encourage participants to arrive at the Hilton in good time to avoid delays.

For security reasons, all visitors are required to pass through a metal detector and all visitors' bags shall be examined.

6. GENERAL INFORMATION

WEATHER:

- The average temperature in Yaoundé in September is fairly hot at 23.1 °C (73.58 °F).
- Afternoons can be hot with average high temperatures reaching 27.2 °C (81 °F).

LOCAL CURRENCY

The local currency is the Central African CFA Franc (XAF). Its exchange rate is about XAF580 to 1 USD. Foreign currency exchange services are available at the hotel or airport.

MONEY/CREDIT CARDS

Hotels accept most credit cards, however please feel free to inquire directly from the establishment.

INTERNET FACILITIES

There is complementary Wi-Fi at the meeting venue.

TELEPHONE COSTS

These are usually expensive at hotels, so please check your bills carefully and settle directly with the hotel on your departure.

MEDICAL

Please ensure that you have adequate travel medical insurance before your departure to Cameroon. The hotel will provide first aid/emergency medical service. Contact the reception/secretariat.

HOTEL BILL

Please check your bill the night before departure and settle your incidentals to avoid misunderstandings when you check out.

PLUG TYPES

Electrical sockets (outlets) in Cameroon are one of the two European standard electrical socket types:
