Initiative for Food and Nutrition Security in Africa – 1st Partners Meeting

Africa is the only continent where the number of undernourished people is increasing and has reached over 230 million, or one out of five does not have adequate amount of food. The first Partners Meeting of the Initiative for Food Security and Nutrition in Africa (IFNA) will be held from May 18 to 19, 2017, in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia.
